(North End Road, Steeple Claydon)

(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER, 2018

BUCKINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL has made an Order, which will temporarily prohibit any vehicle from proceeding, except for access, in that length of North End Road, Steeple Claydon, which commences from junction of Sportsman Close.

The alternative route for vehicles affected by the closure will be via North End Road, West Street, Chaloners Hill, Queen Catherine Road, Buckingham Road, Herds Hill and vice versa.

The closure is required whilst ECL works take place and it is anticipated that the works will commence on 12 March 2018 and will take approximately two weeks to complete.

The Order will come into operation on 12 March 2018 when the appropriate signs are lawfully displayed and will continue for a period not exceeding eighteen months or until the said works have been completed whichever is the earlier.

Penalties for not observing these restrictions will be as prescribed by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and the Road Traffic Act 1991.
