



NOTICE OF UTILITY WORKS What are we doing?

As part of the preparation for the development of HS₂ and the associated construction activities in the Calvert area Western Power Distribution will be continuing with the next phase of utility works following on from the relocation of the substation.

Works will include

Cable Diversions – There are nine underground cables diversions required to redirect the cables into the new primary sub substation. The works will commence June 2018 & will be completed December 2018.

How will this affect me?

Traffic – There will be additional site access signage being installed along Addison Road and Queen Catherine Road.

24 Hour Working – There is an element of the works that Western Power Distribution is required to complete as 24 hour working. This phase of works encompasses the installation of eight cable ducts under the existing Bicester to Bletchley Railway Line. These works are due to commence on 2nd July 2018 and should take approximately four weeks. There will be no working Sunday nights (18:00-07:00).

Working hours

- Normal working hours: Monday to Friday 8am-6pm, Saturdays 8am-1pm with exception of drilling under the Bicester to Bletchley Railway Line.
- Drilling under the railway line working hours will be: Monday 00:00 to Sunday 18:00 for approximately 4 weeks.
- Our contractors may also be on site for one hour's startup and shutdown.

What to expect

- The site will be secured with construction fencing & acoustic barriers
- The speed limit will be reduced to 40mph on Addison road near the site, to ensure vehicles can access and exit the area safely.

What we will do

- Inform you in advance of any changes to the dates shown.
- Keep all sites safe and secure.
- Ensure that the contractor vehicles use agreed routes.
- Ensure that all sites are reinstated to the required standard.
